Overview

Amped Up Rock School delivers structured, in-school band sessions for primary and secondary schools.

The programme runs during the school day, using school space, with all instruments and equipment available where required.

Students learn to play in small groups, building confidence, teamwork, and real musical ability over time.

What We Provide

Amped Up Rock School manages the full delivery of the programme.

We provide:

- Weekly 30-minute band sessions
- Small groups of 3 to 7 students
- AccessNI checked, experienced tutors
- Structured, consistent delivery
- Setup and pack-down each session

All instruments and equipment can be provided by Amped Up Rock School where needed.

Where a school already has suitable equipment, we are happy to use this where practical.

This allows the programme to adapt to each school while remaining fully self-sufficient when required.

What the School Provides

To run the programme, we require:

- A suitable indoor space such as a hall, classroom, or music room
- Access during agreed times within the school day
- A staff contact for coordination

Existing music equipment can be used where suitable, but this is not required.

We aim to integrate smoothly into the school timetable with minimal disruption.

How the Programme Works

- Students are grouped by age and ability
- Each group attends at the same time each week
- The same tutor works with the same group
- Sessions take place during the school day
- Instruments are rotated early on, then students settle into one

Consistency is central to the programme.

Primary and Secondary Fit

The programme is adapted to suit different age groups.

Primary Schools

- Focus on introduction, confidence, and enjoyment
- Beginner-friendly structure
- Strong emphasis on participation

Secondary Schools

- Greater focus on progression and skill development
- Students move more quickly onto a primary instrument
- Suitable for both beginners and developing students

The core structure remains the same across both settings.

Benefits for the School

The programme supports:

- Student confidence and self-expression
- Engagement through creative activity
- Social development and teamwork
- Access to music without cost barriers

Because sessions run during the school day, they are accessible to a wider range of students.

Safeguarding and Compliance

Amped Up Rock School operates to appropriate safeguarding standards.

- All tutors are AccessNI checked
- Public liability insurance is in place
- Safeguarding awareness is maintained
- Clear communication with school staff

We work within each school's safeguarding and operational policies.

Noise and Environment

Sessions are run at controlled, appropriate volume levels.

- Sound is managed for indoor school settings
- Tutors actively control volume
- Equipment is suitable for beginner environments

The programme is designed for a school setting, not a rehearsal environment.

Administration and Communication

We manage:

- Parent communication
- Booking and trial sessions
- Payment collection
- Group organisation

The school is not required to manage administration.

We maintain a clear point of contact for coordination.

Trial and Setup

Trial sessions are only offered in schools where the programme is already running.

For new schools:

- We assess interest from parents and the school
- Where there is sufficient demand, groups are formed
- A timetable is agreed
- Weekly sessions begin

We work with the school to ensure the setup is practical and sustainable.

Capacity and Rollout

Programmes are introduced gradually.

We prioritise:

- Schools with clear parent interest
 - Practical scheduling within the school day
 - Consistent delivery quality
